ML not at meeting.</p> <p>At this point there was discussion about how D&amp;TC should deal with NICE TAs recommending use within the CDF vs NICE TAs where the drug was previously in use via the CDF. Previously, new cancer drugs were allowed to be used if they were listed on the national CDF list. D&amp;TC then requested a new product request form if they later moved to become NICE TA recommended. D&amp;TC had not received forms for many of these requests, and there was seemingly no incentive for clinicians to fill in the form for a drug which was already in clinical use. It was felt that a better process would be to ask the clinicians to complete the new product request form when NICE had reviewed a new drug and decided to give full approval as a TA, or as a TA recommending use within the CDF. Dr Ming had replied indicating that the numbers predicted were indeed correct, but that safinamide would be almost the last "add on" treatment in patients with severe Parkinson's. Where a MAOI was required, rasagaline or selegiline would be used first. Safinamide would be reserved for patents that had not responded or had side effects to these.
