Joint Formulary status Blue: guideline led, prescribed on advice of specialist or in line with national / local guideline (from August 2019).</p> <p>The specialist team will provide the patient with a 2 week sensor supply and the FreeStyle Libre® device and will notify the GP their patient has been initiated.</p> <p>GPs will then issue a prescription for 2 FreeStyle Libre® sensors per month. At 6 months, the specialist team will review the patient and advise the GP if the patient is to continue to receive Freestyle Libre on prescription.</p> <p>7 litres DOOP sharps bins will be supplied initially by the hospital team. Future supplies are prescribable on FP10 prescriptions. 	<p>Sensors measure levels of glucose in interstitial fluid.</p> <p>Patients still require a blood glucose monitor and test strips for checking blood glucose +/- or ketone test strips, when levels are changing rapidly eg. for monitoring hypos/hypers and if driving, for mandatory blood glucose monitoring for DVLA rules.</p> <p>Freestyle Optimum Blood glucose testing strips and Freestyle Optium β ketone testing strips can be prescribed in primary care and used with the Freestyle Libre and Freestyle Libre 2 reader. Insert the strip into the test strip port and apply a fingertip blood sample. Results are recorded in the reader.</p> <p>It is more cost effective to use a standard blood glucose meter with lower cost test strips if frequent blood glucose/ ketone monitoring is required.</p>	Available through Adult or Paediatric Diabetes Clinic only
