Traffic Light Classification within HERPC:

RED – specialist prescriber only

AMBER – prescribed in accordance with approved shared care framework

BLUE (Guideline or Specialist Led) – prescribed on advice of specialist or in line with national / local guideline

GREEN – other items listed on formulary suitable for initiation and prescribing by any prescriber

Invertase Syrup Approved for genetic disaccharide enzyme deficiency.

Chloroprocaine Hydrochloride Approved for spinal anaesthesia where surgery will not exceed 40 minutes

Dimethyl Fumarate Approved in line with NICE TA475 for treating moderate to severe plaque psoriasis
