#### **Traffic Light Classification within HERPC:**

For Joint Formulary go to

**RED** – specialist prescriber only

AMBER – prescribed in accordance with approved shared care framework BLUE (Guideline or Specialist Led) – prescribed on advice of specialist or in line with national / local guideline GREEN – other items listed on formulary suitable for initiation and prescribing by any prescriber

### **ADDITIONS TO RED LIST**

Cannabidiol Oil (Epidiolex) Unlicensed – Epilepsy that has proven intractable to treatment with conventional licensed antiepileptic drugs given at therapeutic doses

Nivolumab – Melanoma stage III and IV
