Traffic Light Classification within HERPC:

RED - specialist prescriber only

AMBER – prescribed in accordance with approved shared care framework BLUE (Guideline or Specialist Led) – prescribed on advice of specialist or in line with

national / local guideline

GREEN – other items listed on formulary suitable for initiation and prescribing by any prescriber

GREEN DRUGS

Ciprofloxacin 2mg/ml Ear Drops - bacterial ear infections of the outer ear

Levosert- IUD

Ultrogestan – second line choice after medroxyprogesterone acetate for progestogenic opposition of oestrogen HRT in women with an intact uterus
