Traffic Light Classification within HERPC:

RED – specialist prescriber only

AMBER – prescribed in accordance with approved shared care framework

BLUE (Guideline or Specialist Led) – prescribed on advice of specialist or in line with national / local guideline

GREEN – other items listed on formulary suitable for initiation and prescribing by any prescriber

Selexipag to treat PAH in line with NHSE guidance

Brolucizumab to treat nAMD

Liposomal Cytarabine-Daunorubicin to treat untreated acute myeloid leukaemia in line with TA552

Dolutegravir/Lamivudine to treat HIV

Lanadelumab or Prevention of recurrent attacks of hereditary angioedema in line with TA606

Cemiplimab for metastatic or locally advanced cutaneous squamous cell carcinoma in line with TA592

Gemtuzumab for untreated acute myeloid leukaemia in line with TA545
