Traffic Light Classification within HERPC:

RED – specialist prescriber only

AMBER – prescribed in accordance with approved shared care framework BLUE (Guideline or Specialist Led) – prescribed on advice of specialist or in line with

national / local guideline

GREEN – other items listed on formulary suitable for initiation and prescribing by any

prescriber
